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U.S. Armed Forces Service Ribbon (Supersedes D.N. 21-108)



The Department has approved a recognition ribbon for members who have served in one of the five branches of the U.S. Military OR are currently serving.

The U.S. Armed Forces Service Ribbon is a display of honor and appreciation from the San Francisco Police Department for the continued service of sworn members who have served in the U.S. Military prior to joining the SFPD OR are currently serving as a Reservist or National Guardsman.

Criteria to receive the U.S. Armed Forces Service Ribbon:

- Sworn member to have served in one of the five branches of the U.S. Military OR
- Sworn member are currently serving as a Reservist or National Guardsman
- Submit a copy of DD-214 with an approved memo
- Received an Honorable Discharge

The U.S. Armed Forces Service Ribbon will be worn on Officer's Class A Jacket or Class AA Jacket for Commissioned Officers. It shall be displayed after all SFPD Unit Citation ribbons.

Officers seeking the U.S. Armed Forces Service Ribbon should submit a memorandum and attach required documentation through their chain of command to Sergeant Maina Tuimavave #685 at Ingleside Station.
