Possession of fireworks in San Francisco is a crime punishable by fine, incarceration in county jail or both.

In light of the recent hot weather and serious drought conditions that exist throughout the region, the threat of fire from fireworks is very real. Something as simple as a sparkler burns at temperatures of up to 1,800 degrees, a temperature hot enough to melt metal. There are numerous fireworks displays throughout the Bay Area so leave fireworks to the professionals.
