San Francisco Police investigators are asking for the public's assistance in locating a violent aggravated assault suspect.

On May 9, 2015 at approximately 11:05 am, the victim was walking near the intersection of Grant and Geary. The suspect, for no reason, called the victim a derogatory name and attacked the victim by punching her in the face and knocking her to the ground. The suspect fled the scene on foot. The victim, a 38 year old female, received a serious injury to her face. She received medical treatment at the Emergency Room that day, and she is still receiving treatment for the injury.
