- -Those hosting celebrations and servers must limit drinks to your guests or patrons. Don't serve more than one or two over several hours.

- -Cut back on the amount of drinks you plan to bring to the party and provide plenty of food.
- -If you see dangerous driving, Report Drunk Drivers Call 9-1-1!

Funding for the Avoid checkpoint is by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. The San Francisco Police Department in conjunction with allied agencies will deploy checkpoints and DUI patrols throughout the winter season.
