On July 16, 2019 at approximately 5:30PM, members of the United States Marshals Service took 20 year-old Eleasia Fraise into custody in Stockton, California. Fraise, a

San Francisco resident, was arrested on a warrant for hit-and-run with injury, gross vehicular manslaughter, arson, and conspiracy (all felonies) and driving without a license (misdemeanor). The warrant was issued in connection with a fatal hit-and-run collision that occurred in the early morning hours of September 22, 2017 at Toland and Jerrold Streets in San Francisco.
