The San Francisco Police Department recognizes that the Public Health Order requiring residents to shelter in place and to practice social distancing creates a challenge to completing routine tasks. The SFPD wants to safeguard the public's health and safety and minimize the need for people to go out in public. For these reasons, **the SFPD Crime Information Services Unit (Records Room) public service windows at Police Headquarters will close on Friday, March 20, 2020 at Noon.**

In order to safely continue to serve the public and provide the highest level of customer service during this emergency, the Department is asking the public to **[make requests for copies of police reports](#) online; or by calling CISU at [1-415-575-7232](#) between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.**

Victims of domestic violence, sexual assaults, stalking, human trafficking, and elder / dependent abuse should use the SFPD website to [order a Copy of a Police Report](#); email SFPD.Records@sfgov.org; or call CISU during business hours [1-415-575-7232](#) to obtain prompt service for their report requests.
