San Francisco Police Homicide Investigators are seeking assistance in solving the 2006 murder of Aubrey Abrakasa Jr. On August 14, 2006, at 3:14 PM, the 17-year-old student was shot multiple times and killed at the intersection of Grove and Baker Streets.

Aubrey's mother, Paulette Brown, has been a tireless advocate for her son and for the families of other murder victims.

On Friday, August 14, 2020, at 3:00 PM, Ms. Brown will be at Grove and Baker Streets handing out fliers and will be available to speak to the media with social distancing protocols and facial coverings. A member of the SFPD Homicide Detail and Media Relations staff will be available to the press as well.
