Investigators from the San Francisco Police Department's Missing Persons Unit have obtained new information that missing juvenile Katlin Gallaread is possibly in the company of a runaway juvenile from Monroe, MI.

Katlin is described as a fourteen-year-old, black female, 5'01" and 90 pounds. The missing juvenile from Monroe, MI is named Tyler Sexton and is described as a sixteen-year-old white male, 5'6" and 155 lbs.

The two are believed to be traveling together and their last known location was in Sacramento, CA. They may be traveling by bus or train.
