# San Francisco Police Investigate Bayview Suspicious Death 22-069

On May 23, 2022, at approximately 5:18 am, San Francisco Police Officers assigned to Bayview Station responded to the unit block of Osceola on a report of a shooting. When officers arrived on scene, they located a 30-year-old female victim suffering from an apparent gunshot wound inside a residence. Officers rendered aid and requested paramedics to the scene. Paramedics from the San Francisco Fire Department responded, and the victim was declared deceased at the scene. The San Francisco County Medical Examiner responded and declared the death suspicious. Due to the suspicious nature of the death, investigators from the SFPD Homicide Detail responded to the scene and are leading the investigation.
