Officers arrived on scene and located an adult male suffering from injuries caused by a gunshot wound. Officers rendered aid and summoned medical attention. Despite lifesaving efforts by the emergency responders and medical staff, the victim succumbed to their injuries and was declared deceased in the hospital.
