

The San Francisco Police Department's 277th Recruit Class will be sworn in Thursday, January 26, 2023, by San Francisco Police Chief Bill Scott. There are 12 graduating recruit officers. Four graduates are bilingual and fluent in languages such as Spanish, Portuguese and Cantonese.

The 277th Recruit Class has six members who have earned Bachelor's degrees or Associate's degrees. Members of the class have previously been employed as security professionals, teachers, customer service representatives, and delivery personnel to name a few. These officers also represent the United States Military Branches of the Army, Navy, and Army National Guard.
