San Francisco Police Offer Resources to the Chinese Community Affected by Blessing and Healing Scams 24-008

San Francisco Police urge all members of the Chinese community to be suspicious of strangers claiming to provide relief from a curse or illness or those who provide “purification” ceremonies in which cash and valuable items must be offered as part of the process.

Please [review the previously released video](#) on various ways to identify potential scammers, how to protect yourself from a scam, and reporting resources available to scam victims.

In two recent cases, the suspects were described as one Asian male between the ages of 50 to 60 years and two Asian females ranging in age from early 30s to 60 years old. All of the suspects were described as having black hair and brown eyes and were often wearing masks that covered their mouths.

Anyone who is confronted by scammers or anyone who knows of an elder who scammers approached is strongly advised to contact the police. Reports can be

made at any SFPD District Station or by calling Dispatch at [\(415\) 553-0123](tel:(415)553-0123) and requesting an officer to take a report.
