SFPD Investigates Mission District Homicide 24-071

On July 9th, 2024, at approximately 12:17 a.m., San Francisco Police Officers responded to the 1900 block of Mission Street regarding a shooting.

Officers were advised that multiple callers heard several gunshots and what sounded like a vehicle collision.

Officers arrived on scene and observed a vehicle collision had occurred between a vehicle and several unoccupied parked cars. Officers located a victim suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Officers rendered aid, including cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR). Paramedics responded to the scene and rendered aid as well. Despite the lifesaving efforts by first responders and medical personnel, the victim was pronounced deceased at the scene.

While on scene, officers were advised that there were possibly two additional victims. Through the course of the investigation, it was determined that one victim was evaluated for possible injuries at a local hospital. The second victim sustained an apparent gunshot wound and was treated by medical staff for non-life-threatening injuries.

The SFPD Homicide unit responded to the scene and is leading this investigation.
