

***Sketches attached to help identify suspects***

On January 18, 2002, at approximately 2:30 a.m., Perry Bradstreet was robbed, carjacked, and fatally shot as he ran away from the suspects. Mr. Bradstreet's vehicle was set ablaze by the unknown suspects and abandoned in the Oakdale Housing Project. Despite the lifesaving efforts of emergency responders, Mr. Bradstreet succumbed to his injuries.

This investigation is being led by the SFPD Homicide Detail.

The San Francisco Police Department authorized a \$100,000 reward for information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the suspects in this case.

Also shown are sketches of the suspects that investigators are looking to identify, locate, and arrest.
