

On August 14<sup>th</sup> 2006, at approximately 3:00 in the afternoon, Aubrey Abrakasa Jr. was killed in the intersection of Grove and Baker Streets. Mr. Abrakasa was a popular 17 year old.

On Monday, August 14 at 2PM, Ms. Brown will be at Grove and Baker Streets handing out fliers and available to speak to the media.
