The enhancement of the Investigations Bureau was developed as part of a comprehensive plan that includes the doubling of foot patrols deployed citywide and a focus on education and crime prevention to address auto burglaries and crimes of opportunity. “Public safety is our top priority,” said Chief Scott. “The San Francisco Police Department is laser-focused on reversing crime trends in our City by working closely together with the community and through the smart deployment of our personnel and resources.”
