On Friday, March 24, 2017 at approximately 3:04 PM, a suspect broke the store front window of a jewelry store located on the 100 block of Waverly Place in the Chinatown district. The suspect stole approximately \$100,000 worth of jewelry. The suspect was last seen running away from the jewelry store southbound on Waverly

Place and then eastbound on Sacramento Street.
