In 2014, Chinatown Night Out, modeled after National Night Out, was established in an effort to reach the monolingual speaking Chinese Community. The San Francisco Police Department's goal is to build trust and long lasting partnerships between the community and the police. When relationships are formed and trust is established, the community feels comfortable to report crime.

SFPD's plan is to educate the community this year on the importance of crime prevention as it relates to robberies, burglaries, blessing scams, cell phone theft, residential "tailgating", security cameras and personal safety. We will also communicate our message on Vision Zero and stress the importance of pedestrian safety.
