



Mission Incidents

Assault, Aggravated, W/Knife

Date: 01/18/19 0220 hrs Where: 1600 block of 15th Street

On 01-18-19 at approximately 0223 hours, Ofc. Ramoso #658 and Ofc. Castaneda #451 were on patrol, in a marked unit, and in uniform. They were traveling Westbound on 15th, approaching Julian Ave.

They were flagged down by a male later identified as reporting witness 1 (RW1) Perez, who was standing on the Northwest corner of 15th and Julian Ave. Reporting witness 1 yelled out to them saying his friend was attacked. Reporting witness 1 was standing next to a male later identified as reporting victim 1 (RV1) Galvez. Ofc. Castaneda got out of the patrol vehicle and approached reporting witness 1 and reporting victim 1. Reporting witness 1 stated that a short male had assaulted reporting victim with a knife. Reporting victim 1 stated that the suspect was a short male, and was standing at the Northeast corner of 15th and Caledonia. Both reporting victim 1 and reporting witness 1 pointed to a short male with a dark back pack, and dark ball cap, standing and leaning against the wall on the Northeast corner of 15th and Caledonia. The male was later identified as Suspect 1. Reporting witness 1 informed Ofc. Castaneda that suspect 1 had tried to cut reporting victim 1 with a knife. Ofc. Ramoso detained suspect 1.

Reporting victim 1 stated suspect 1 approached him from the 15th Street side, and began to punch him in the face with a closed right fist, approximately 4 to 5 times. Reporting victim 1 stated he then saw that suspect 1 was holding an orange knife in his right hand. Reporting victim 1 stated suspect 1 made a swiping motion towards him while standing next to him. Reporting witness 1 stated that the swiping motion with the knife caused a large cut to reporting victim 1's jacket, which reporting victim 1 was wearing at the time.

While Ofc. Castaneda was speaking with reporting witness 1 and Ofc. Roman was speaking with reporting victim 1, Ofc. Ospital searched the area for the knife, Ofc. Ospital located the orange box cutter, in the unit block of Caledonia which is just North of 15th street, on the east sidewalk of Caledonia. Suspect 1 was later transported to Mission Station where he was subsequently booked on the above listed charges.

Mission Incidents

Robbery, W/ Force, Stolen Property, Possession with Knowledge, Receiving.

Date: 01/19/19 1016 hours Where: 3800 Block 24th Street

On 01/19/2019 at approximately 1016 hours Ofc. Edgerson #714 was in full police uniform and in a marked San Francisco patrol vehicle. Ofc. Edgerson responded to 3810 24th St "Shoe Biz" for a report of a robbery. Upon arrival, Ofc. Edgerson was met by the manager of "Shoe Biz" reporting victim 1 Gerald who pointed W/B 24th St and alerted me she's walking that way.

Reporting victim 1 described the suspect as later identified suspect 1, as a Latin female wearing an olive green jacket with cheetah print. Reporting victim 1 informed me that suspect 1 hit her in the head and took an olive green jacket. Multiple units searched the area, Officer Macintosh #2168 and Boyle #2086 located suspect 1 in front of 3914 24th St. Ofc Macintosh detained suspect 1. Ofc. Edgerson conducted a cold show with reporting witness 1 (RW1) Tiara Norbert. Norbert stated, "yes that's her, I just remember her." Ofc. Edgerson spoke with reporting witness 1 who provided the following in summary: reporting witness 1 was working at "Shoe Biz" and noticed suspect 1 walk into the store and start talking to herself erratically. Suspect 1 walked to the rear of the store, grabbed three jackets and put them on. Suspect 1 then took off the jackets and walked to the front of the store towards the exit. Reporting victim 1 asked suspect 1 to put the jackets down and leave the store. Suspect 1 dropped two of the three jackets on the ground. Ofc Gerald bent down to pick up the jackets. Suspect 1 grabbed the jackets at the same time, suspect 1 and reporting victim 1 pulled the jackets at the same time. suspect 1 then swung the third olive green jacket striking reporting victim 1 in the head. Reporting victim 1 let the jackets go and suspect 1 walked away. Two customers stepped between suspect 1 and reporting victim 1 to stop the altercation Ofc Boyle and Ofc Stewart transported suspect 1 to Mission Station where suspect 1 was subsequently booked on above listed charges.







Register Your bicycle

UCSF Campus:

If you have a valid UC ID, bring a completed Bicycle Permit Application to our Parnassus or Mission Bay parking office to obtain a free permit and gain access to our Parnassus, Mission Bay or Mt. Zion bike cages.

As an added layer of protection, registration stickers are required for all bicycles parked inside UCSF bike rooms and cages

On SF SAFE Website:

The SAFE Bikes sticker and ID code have been instrumental in helping law enforcement get recovered bikes back to their owners. To register your bike with SAFE Bikes, you will need:

Make, model, serial number and complete description of the bicycle.

A photo of the purchase receipt

A photo of the bicycle

The SAFE Bikes Registration Form will open in a new tab. If the tab doesn't open, please send an email with your name and address and we'll get you started with bike registration.

After your registration is complete, you will receive a sticker in the mail to place on your bike.
