## Off-Duty Concealed Carry PROHIBITED at Chase Center

Off-duty law enforcement officers who do not have an authorized, working, event-day function, will be banned from bringing weapons into Chase Center. No firearms will be allowed into Chase Center except for those carried by law enforcement officers working in a pre-approved event-day capacity and assigned to the event. This ban will also apply to licensed CCW patrons.

The Chase Center is secured through a number of measures including, but not limited to magnetometers, metal detecting wands, pat-downs and explosive detection canines.

You will be denied access to enter the Chase Center if you are off-duty and carrying a firearm. There will be NO weapons storage on the property. Members are required to adhere to Department Bulletin 17-202, Firearm Security in Vehicles, and should familiarize themselves with San Francisco Police Code 3602B as it relates to the storage of firearms.
