

### **OIS 22-002**

On April 15, 2022, at approximately 00:06 hours, an SFPD Sergeant was involved in an Officer Involved Shooting while off-duty in the city of Concord, CA. The Sergeant was awakened by the sound of gunshots outside of their residence. The Sergeant saw the suspect holding a handgun and firing it at a vehicle. The Sergeant grabbed their off-duty firearm and yelled at the suspect repeatedly to stop. The suspect began shooting at the Sergeant, who then returned fire with their off-duty weapon. The suspect fled the scene in an unknown vehicle. Concord Police Department responded to the scene and initiated an investigation. **Open**

### **OIS 22-003**

On May 19, 2022, Officers responded to a call for service of an aggravated assault at an encampment underneath the freeway overpass located at Mariposa Street and Owens Street. Multiple uniformed SFPD Officers arrived on scene to find two subjects lying on the ground in an active struggle with a knife. Both subjects had visible injuries from their altercation. Over the course of an approximate nine-minute standoff, Officers gave numerous commands for the subjects to drop the weapon with no compliance. Officers discharged multiple less lethal weapons to no avail. One subject eventually climbed on top of the other and attempted to stab the second subject, resulting in an Officer-involved shooting. Officers rendered aid, but both subjects succumbed to their injuries. **Open**

### **OIS 22-004**

On Wednesday, June 15, 2022, at approximately 13:21 hours, in the 500 block of Moscow Street (San Francisco), an off-duty officer died from a self-inflicted gunshot wound. **Not In Policy.**

### **OIS 22-005**

On August 6, 2022, at approximately 07:55 hours, uniformed SFPD officers attempted to detain a subject in the area of 18<sup>th</sup> Street and Shotwell Street for riding a bicycle on the sidewalk. The subject fled from officers and a short foot pursuit ensued. The subject produced a firearm which they pointed and fired at the officers. The officers took cover and discharged their firearms.

Over the time span of nearly an hour, officers attempted to build rapport with the subject and give the subject commands to drop the firearm and surrender, however the subject did not comply. While crouched behind the parked vehicle, the subject pointed the firearm towards officers multiple times and two additional officers discharged Department rifles. SFPD Tactical Unit members eventually detained the subject without incident. The subject was not struck by any gunfire. It was later determined that the subject's firearm was an imitation firearm only capable of firing blank gun cartridges. **Open**
