The Police Officer application process includes various tests and a background investigation.

Ownership of the application process is split between the Department of Human Resources (DHR), which administers all required testing for City employees, and the Police Department (SFPD), which conducts all other aspects of the Police Officer application process.




Visuals & Data


DHR components are analyzed by race and gender. Data for these components is maintained by the DHR Public Safety Team. The SFPD Staffing and Deployment Unit provides data analysis and visuals based on the data received by DHR and has no control over the structure of the data provided, and hence what visuals can be created. Data for candidates entering the backgrounds investigation process and the San Francisco Police Academy is maintained internally by SFPD and visualized and analyzed by the SFPD Staffing and Deployment Unit.






Applicants by Race/Ethnicity





Written Test Pass Rate by Race/Ethnicity




Individuals who **took the NTN** Written Test by Gender




Individuals who took the NTN (Written Test) by Race/Ethnicity



Individuals who **passed the NTN** (Written Test) by Gender





Physical Ability Test: Overall Pass Rate (7/1/2017 - 12/31/2022)




PAT Pass Rate by Race/Ethnicity






Physical Ability Test: Individuals who took the PAT by Gender


Physical Ability Test: Individuals who took the PAT by Race/Ethnicity







Physical Ability Test: Individuals who passed the PAT by Gender

Physical Ability Test: Individuals who passed the PAT by Race/Ethnicity






Oral Interview Pass Rate by Race/Ethnicity




Oral Interview: Individuals who attended the Oral Interview by Gender




Oral Interview: Individuals who attended the Oral Interview by Gender



Oral Interview: Individuals who passed the Oral Interview by Gender








