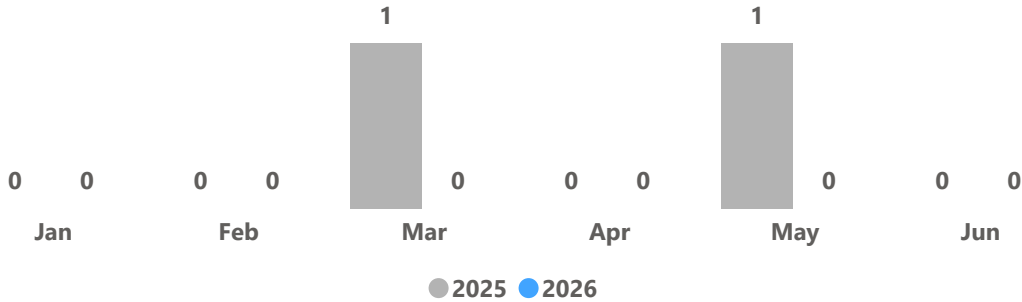

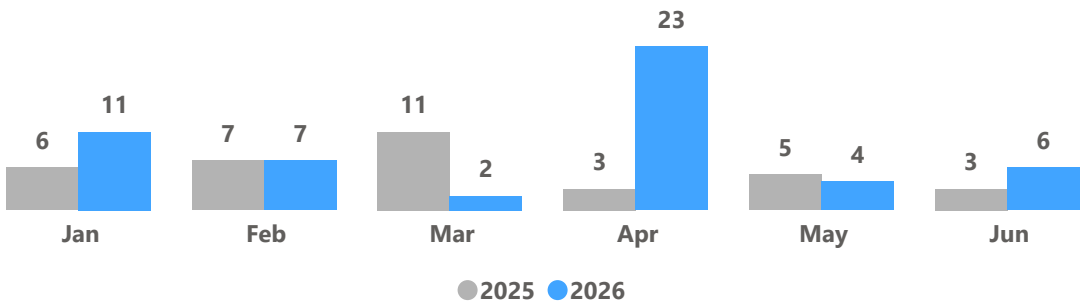

CENTRAL - Firearm Seizures



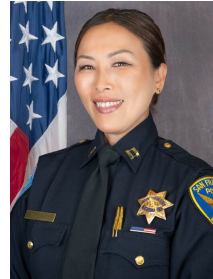

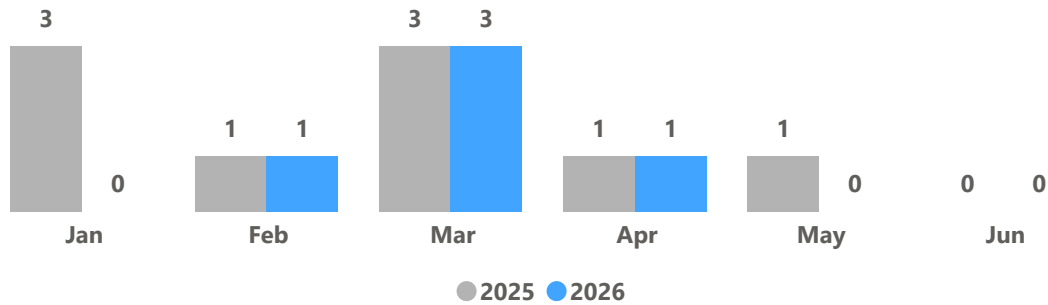

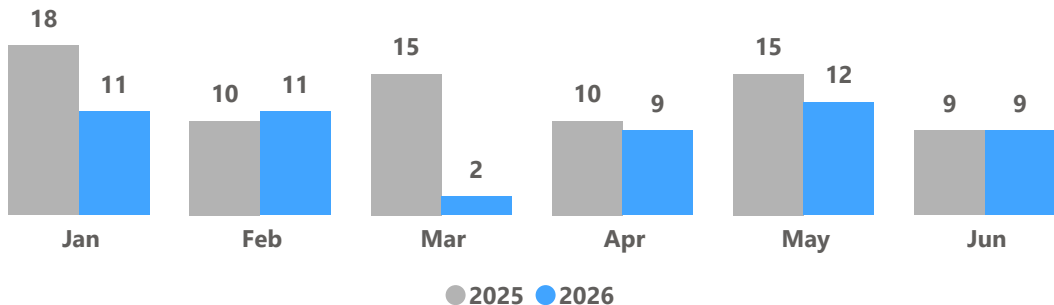

INGLESIDE - Total Shooting Incidents (Non-Fatal Shootings-217 & Homicides by Firearm-187)



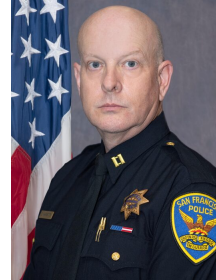
INGLESIDE - Firearm Seizures

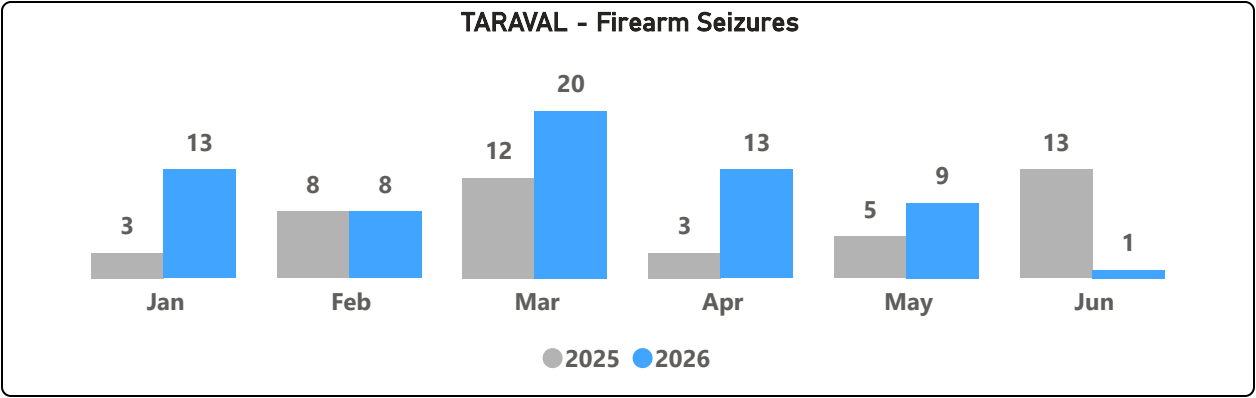
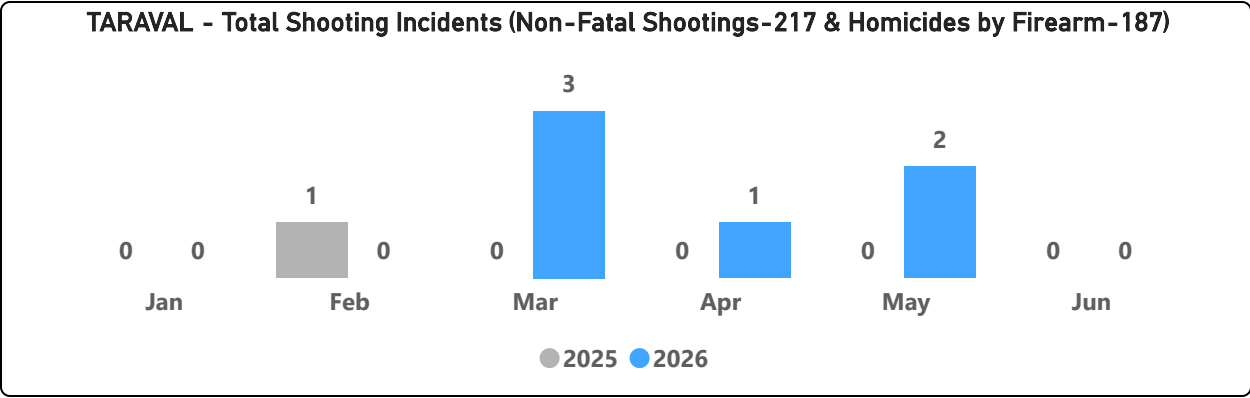
