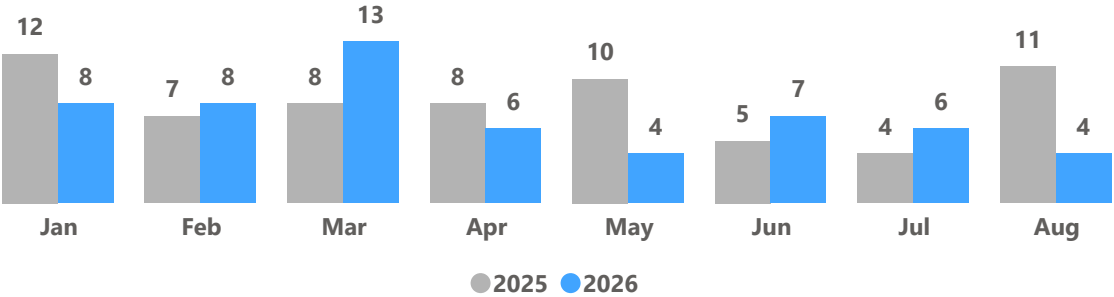

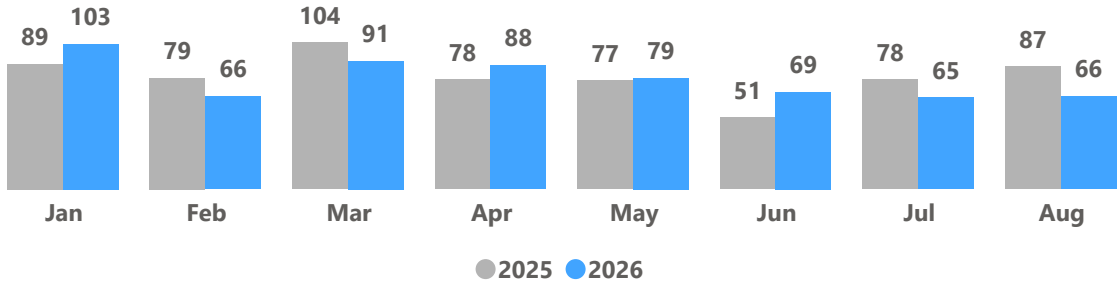

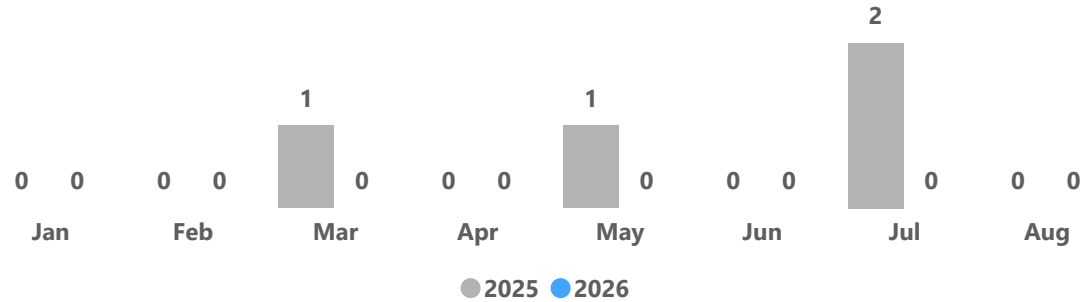

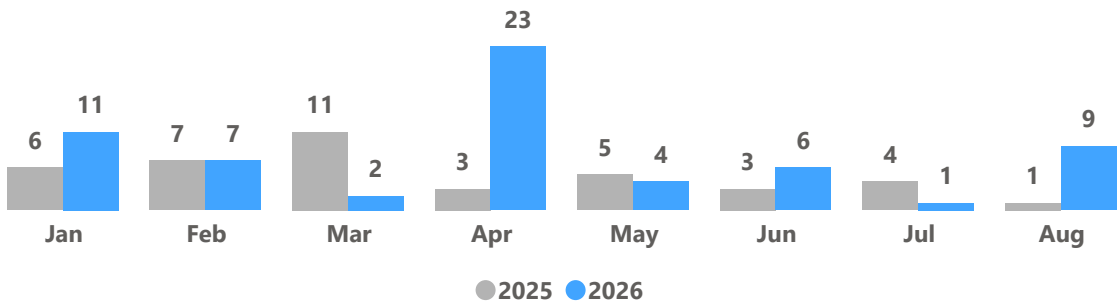

INGLESIDE - Firearm Seizures

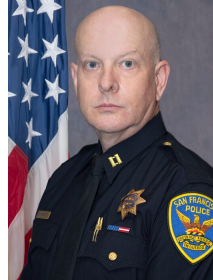

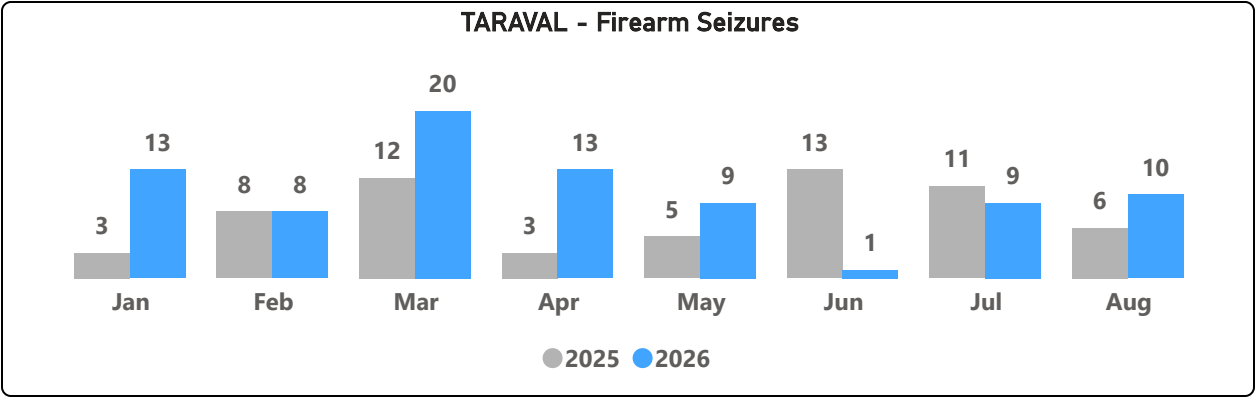
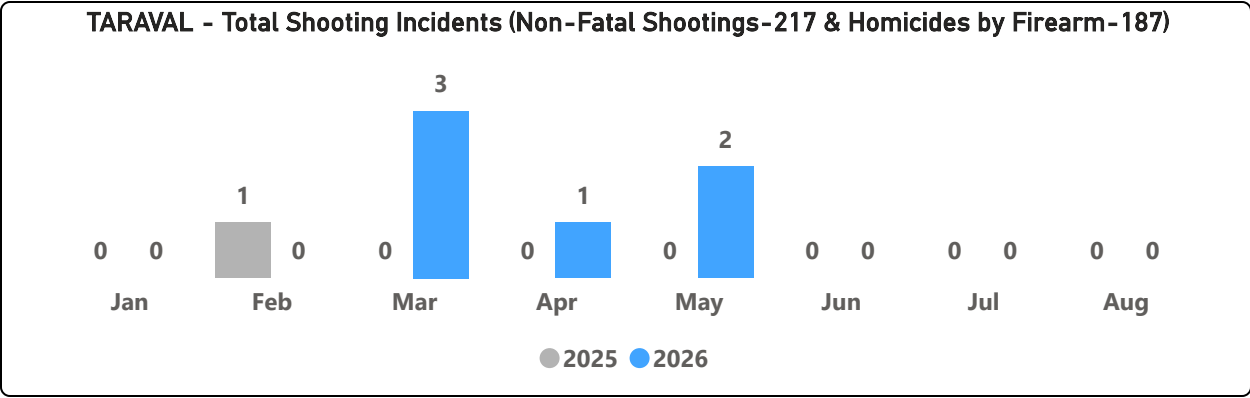
