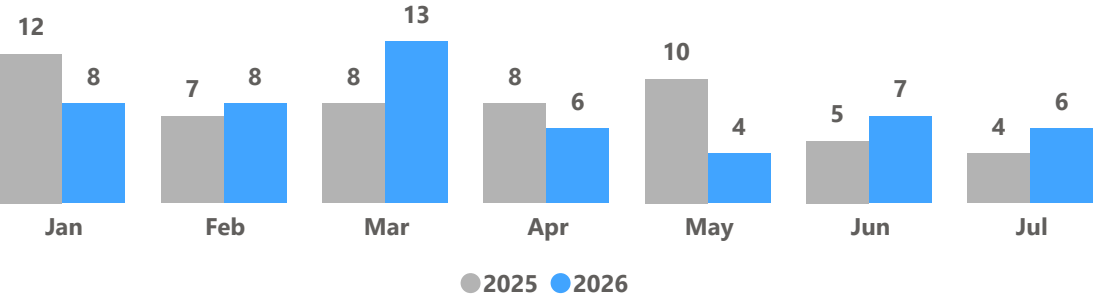

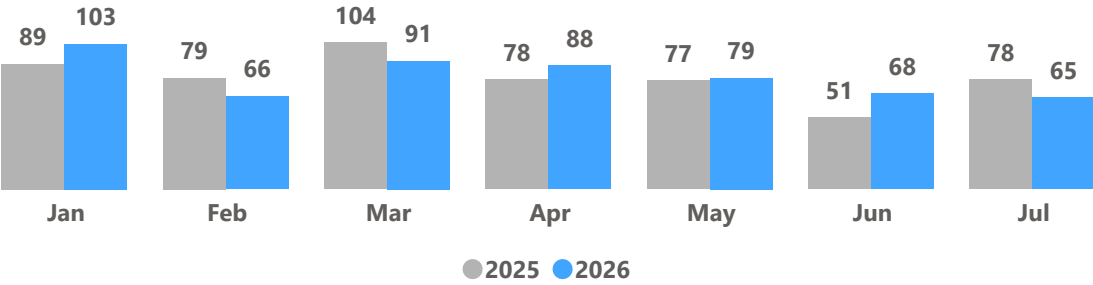

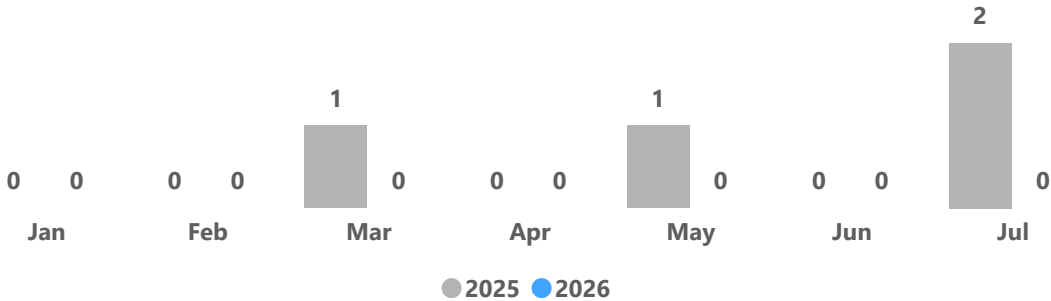

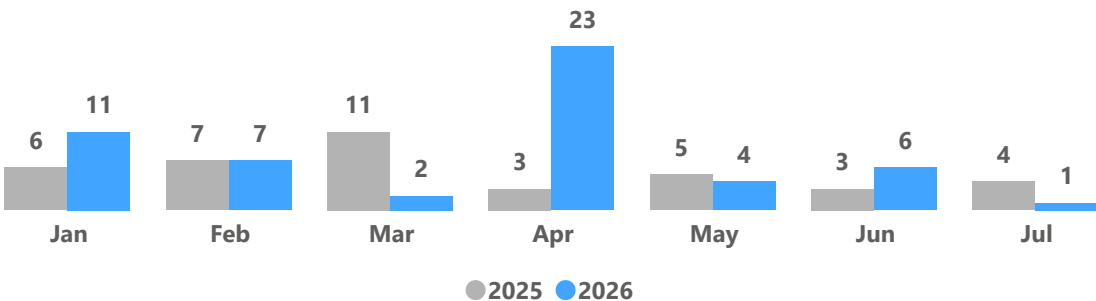

CENTRAL - Firearm Seizures



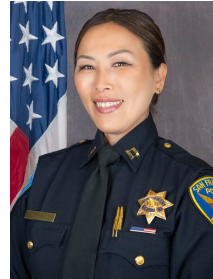
