Finding 20 Finding Manager: Capt. Greg Mar/Gordon Brussow (January agenda)

The SFPD does not capture sufficient data on arrest and use of force incidents to support strong scientific analysis. Because of limitations in the manner in which use of force and arrest data were collected by the SFPD, assessment team members were unable to perform a multivariate frequency analysis, which would have shed light on whether individuals who are members of racial minorities were subjected to force more often than White individuals during arrests.

Recommendation 20.1

Project Manager: Gordon Brussow

The SFPD needs to develop reliable electronic in-custody arrest data. It needs to ensure that these arrest data accurately reflect the incident number from the event, and the number should be cross-referenced on both the booking card and the use of force reporting form.

Recommendation 20.3

Project Manager: Gordon Brussow

The SFPD needs to advocate for better coordination with the San Francisco Sheriff's Department to ensure that the recording of SFPD arrest data is accurate and corresponds with SFPD incident report and arrest data.

Force Options Training – presented by Officer Ryan Jones

The San Francisco Police Department conducts Use of Force training throughout the Department and incorporates that training into the overall tactics and operational planning of many critical incidents. In order to understand the totality of Use of Force incidents and how seriously the Department takes these issues, many things have to be considered, evaluated and employed. The law, Force Science, POST training, and supervisory investigation are all factors which are related to Use of Force.

This particular Force Options Presentation **is a small example** (glimpse) into the types of components involved in Use of Force training for not only new recruit officers but for CPT/ AO (Continued Professional Training / Advanced Officer) mandated for officers every two years. The purpose of this training is to increase knowledge in current use of force law, Improve *skills* in tactics and the selection of appropriate force options by utilization of simulator, and improve *ability* to document a use of force incident. The San Francisco Police Department has been utilizing this type of simulation and scenario based training during the Police Academy and in Roll Call trainings at Unit / Station level. Although Use of Force is a POST requirement, it is incorporated into all kinds of scenario and repetitive training, supervisory investigations.
